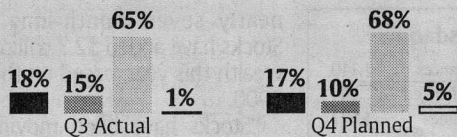

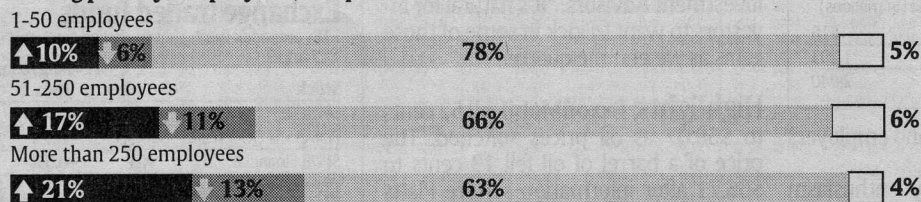

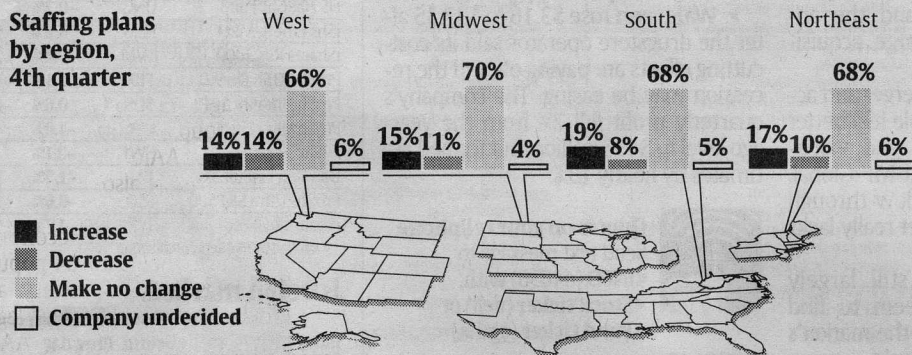

Staffing plans by region, 4th quarter



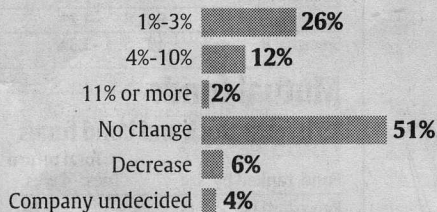
Finding qualified job candidates

What do you expect the average change in salaries will be for full-time permanent employees, at your location, in the 4th quarter of 2009 compared with the 4th quarter of 2008?

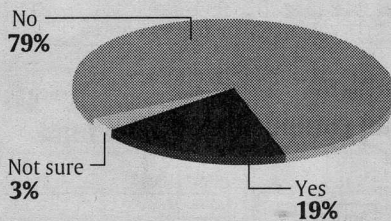
